### **COLORADO PARKS AND WILDLIFE SUPPORTS WILD I-70 AUDIO TOUR**

Partners in the Outdoors has awarded Rocky Mountain Wild a \$2,500 grant to support the marketing and production of the Wild I-70 Audio Tour. The Wild I-70 Audio Tour is available by downloading the free izi.travel app. The tour runs from Golden to Glenwood Springs, with short segments that tell the story of the I-70 Mountain Corridor and wildlife who live there. Topics include migration, habitat connectivity, lynx reintroduction, and much more. Each segment features a different Colorado musician and the tour is narrated by Stephen Brackett of the Flobots/Youth on Record.

“The Wild I-70 Audio Tour not only showcases the wild places outside your windshield in a different light, it is a fantastic way to show the collaborative efforts between Rocky Mountain Wild, Colorado Parks and Wildlife, the US Forest Service, and private entities who all support wildlife crossing structures in Colorado,” says Erica Prather, Producer of the Wild I-70 Audio Tour. “We are very excited to have the support of CPW.”

Grant funds will be used to create additional segments of the audio tour , and assist in the cost of marketing.
